

**RULES AND REGULATIONS
WASHINGTON EVERGREEN AWARD**

**ARTICLE I
ELIGIBILITY**

Section 1. This award shall be made in recognition of outstanding service to the Order.

(a) Any adult (excluding elected members of the GGC during their term of office and the work done therein) with a minimum of five years during the past seven years of outstanding service to the Order, who is at least twenty-five (25) years of age at the time of their nomination. All nominees must be living at the time of nomination. (1994)

**ARTICLE II
REQUIREMENTS**

Section 1. Nomination

(a) Members of a Bethel or a member of the GGC may recommend a nominee to the Executive members of a BGC. (1998)

(b) Nomination shall be approved by any four (4) members of the nominating Bethel Guardian Council. (1998)

Section 2. Recommendations

(a) At least four (4) letters of recommendation from adults who know the nominee personally, other than relatives, shall be submitted with the nomination form. (1998)

(b) At least two (2) of the letters shall be from current members of the BGC (Executive and/or Associate) or from members of the GGC. (1998)

Section 3. Presentation

(a) The recipient shall receive the Washington Evergreen Award during the Formal Opening at the Annual Session of the Grand Guardian Council. In the event that it is impossible for the recipient to attend, other arrangements for the presentation will be made by the Grand Guardian. (2008)

(b) The GGC shall be responsible for providing each recipient with a certificate.

Section 4. General

(a) The cost of the approved award may be paid by the proposer, the family, or anyone who wishes to contribute. Checks should be made payable to the GGC of Washington and sent to the chairman of the Washington Evergreen Award Committee by May 1. (2007)

**ARTICLE III
WASHINGTON EVERGREEN COMMITTEE**

Section 1. Members

(a) The membership of this committee is defined in the WA B-GGC, Art. IV. Sec. 4 (g).

Section 2. Duties of the Committee

(a) Notify each Bethel and members of the GGC on the mailing list, in September, of requirements for a nomination.

(b) Receive the nomination with a postmark of no later than March 1, from a member or members of the GGC. (2007)

(c) Hold an annual meeting by April 1 to determine the recipients of this award in accordance with the Rules and Regulations and nominations form as adopted by the voting delegates of this GGC. (2007)

- (d) Notify each proposer by mail of the committee's decision regarding their nomination by April 15. (2007)
- (e) The committee shall not discuss the nominations outside their annual meeting. The decisions of the committee shall be final, and all nominations shall be destroyed at the conclusion of the GGC Session.

Section 3. Duties of the Committee Chairman

- (a) Designate the date and location of the annual meeting of this committee.
- (b) Submit a report at the Annual Session of the GGC.
- (c) Be custodian of the permanent file containing the list of recipients and copies of all annual reports.
- (d) Turn over all properties of the committee annually to the new chairman.

**ARTICLE IV
AMENDMENTS**
