

## INDIVIDUAL RITUAL CHAPLAIN COMPETITION JOBIE WEEKEND 2019

Individual Ritual **CHAPLAIN Competition** is held at Jobie Weekend and is open to all active members of **JOB'S DAUGHTERS INTERNATIONAL**. You need not to have held this position in order to compete. **DIVISION AND AGE CATEGORIES** may be revised as determined by the entries received by the deadline. There will be an opportunity to win a First, Second or Third Place Medal in each Division. The Daughter with the Highest overall score in the competition, regardless of the division competed in, will be awarded a Best In State Medal.

#### RULES and GUIDELINES

- Must be present to enter Chaplain Competition.
- Entries must be received by the entry deadline of January 31, 2019. No late entries will be accepted. If you would like confirmation your entry was received please email [competeJD@gmail.com](mailto:competeJD@gmail.com).
- Each entrant must **memorize** the **Pledge of Honor for Adults, The Lord's Prayer, Obligation, The Closing Prayer-initiation, Mothers' Fathers' and Guardians Prayer, The Closing Prayer-regular Meeting**. You will need to know the order of the memory work, floor work, attitude of prayer and opening/closing of the Bible. No guidance prompts are given. But if you need a **WORD PROMPT**, three words at a time can be given to you (keep in mind, a point is deducted for each word prompted) you must indicate that you want a prompt by making eye contact with the judge.
  - **Official Robe Judging** –please see the Robe Judging Score Sheet for specific elements judged
  - **Appearance** during the competition-this is a separate score from your Robe judging score.
  - **Floor work, Bible Opening/Closing, Kneeling and Attitude of Prayer** as per the ritual
  - **Memorization and Delivery of Speaking Part, Interpretation and Overall Impression**
- Each Daughter Competing in the **Individual Ritual CHAPLAIN COMPETITION** will enter the competition room and sit in the Chaplains chair. When ready to begin, nod to the judges. Proceed with the Chaplain parts as outlined in the ritual, including kneeling, standing, attitude of prayer and floor work. At the conclusion you will return to the Chaplains chair, be seated and nod to the judges to signal that you are done.
- To see that the same set of standards are applied to all, each daughter competing will be judged by the same set of (3 or 4) judges. It is the choice of the daughter if she would like to have additional observers in the room while she competes. Observers are cautioned not to assist the daughter in any way during the competition. This includes, talking, prompting, mouthing words, nodding or any other gestures to the daughter during competition.
