Individual Ritual **PROFICIENCY Competition** is held at Jobie Weekend and is for **ACTIVE MEMBERS to JOB'S DAUGHTERS INTERNATIONAL only. DIVISION AND AGE CATEGORIES** will be determined by the entries received by the deadline. There will be an opportunity to win a First, Second or Third Place Medal in each Division. The Daughter with the Highest overall score in the competition, regardless of the division competed in, will be awarded a Best In State Medal. You do not have to have taken the Proficiency Exam in your Bethel prior to competing.

RULES and GUIDELINES

- Must be present to enter Individual Proficiency Competition.
- Entries must be received by the entry deadline of January 31, 2019. No late entries will be accepted. If you would like confirmation your entry was received please email competeJD@gmail.com.
- Daughters may only enter this competition once during their time as a Daughter.
- Each entrant must memorize the **PROFICIENCY EXAM**. You will need to obtain a copy of the Secret Work from the Guardian Secretary of your Bethel. **Daughters will be judged on:**
 - **Official Robe Judging** –please see the Robe Judging Score Sheet for specific elements judged
 - **Appearance** during the competition-this is a separate score from your Robe judging score.
 - **Kneeling and Attitude of Prayer** as per the ritual
 - **Delivery of Speaking Part, Interpretation and Overall Impression**
- **Memorization of the Obligation, Signs, Responses, Mothers' Fathers' and Guardians Prayer, The Salutation Sign and The Grip of The Order.** To assist you, a competition judge will read the sentence immediately before each memory part. (Points are not deducted for these sentences.) They will not indicate when you need to perform floor work, attitude of prayer or to kneel.
- If you need a **PROMPT**, three words at a time can be given to you (keep in mind, a point is deducted for each word prompted) You must indicate that you want a prompt by making eye contact with the judge.
- Each Daughter Competing in the **Individual Ritual PROFICIENCY COMPETITION** will enter the competition room and sit in the 5th Messenger chair. When ready to begin, nod to the judges. Begin by taking a position behind the altar between the 1st and 3rd Messenger chairs. Proceed to follow the **PROFICIENCY EXAM** as outlined in the ritual, including kneeling, standing and attitude of prayer on pages 111-113. At the conclusion of the exam, you will return to the 5th messenger chair, be seated and nod to the judges to signal that you are done.
- To see that the same set of standards are applied to all, each daughter competing will be judged by the same set of (3 or 4) judges. It is the choice of the daughter if she would like to have one (1) additional observer in the room while she competes. Observers are cautioned not to assist the daughter in any way during the competition. This includes, talking, prompting, mouthing words, nodding or any other gestures to the daughter during competition.
