We are looking for the **five daughters** who demonstrate the best ritual work to represent Washington State in this prestigious competition. **There will be a four-day mandatory practice held July 26-29th**. The Messenger parts will be determined before the end of Jobie Weekend 2019.

You will all compete at Jobie Weekend with the 1st Messenger Initiation Part.

RULES and GUIDELINES

- Must be present to enter State Ritual Team Competition.
- Entries must be received by the entry deadline of January 31st, 2019. No late entries will be accepted. If you would like confirmation your entry was received please email competeJD@gmail.com.
- All Active members of Jobs Daughters International are eligible to compete for a place on the team. You must be fifteen years old and not have attained the age of twenty on the day of competition at Supreme Session, August 6th, 2019. **Each Daughter selected for the State Ritual Team will be responsible for her own Supreme Session Expenses, Transportation and Chaperone.** Any number of daughters from each Bethel can enter the competition. If the Supreme guidelines change, and more than one team can be entered from each jurisdiction, the rules will be modified, and you will be notified by email of any changes.
- Entrants will be judged on their performance of the initiation part listed above. You must memorize the initiation part, including any directions to the Guide and Marshal.
- Entrants will compete wearing the Official Regalia of the Order, as prescribed in the Supreme Bylaws for Bethels (SOB Bethel 11 Section 1 a & b) No capes or crowns will be worn. Robes will be judged.
- No rituals other than those used by the judges, will be allowed in the room.
- Observers are not permitted in the room during the competition, in accordance with the Supreme Guidelines.
- If a Daughter needs a prompt, one word will be given and one point will be deducted for each word provided to the entrant.

Please use the attached score sheets to understand the criteria for judging. A perfect score is 350 points.

Perfect memory work equals 250 points. 1 point will be deducted for every word omitted and/or additional word given. If the Daughter requires a prompt from the judges, a 1-word prompt will be given resulting in a 1-point deduction from her score. 1 point will be deducted for all pauses longer than four seconds.

If I am selected as a member of the Washington State Ritual Team I...

- Will be physically present and on time to scheduled practices and events
- Will come prepared with necessary supplies, clothing, and assigned ritual work to practices and events
- Will be an active participant at every group activity and fundraiser,
- Will heed the advice and guidance of my coaches,
- Will be a positive TEAM player,
- Will work hard, have fun, and have a good attitude,
- Understand that any Supreme Session costs not covered by fundraising is my responsibility,
- and understand that ****failure to follow the above code of conduct may result in being replaced with an alternate for the Supreme Session competition, even if a portion of my Supreme Session costs have been paid for.**

As a parent of a Washington State Ritual Team member I...

- Will make sure that my child is on time to scheduled practices
- Will make sure that my child is fed, well rested, and ready to participate at scheduled activities,
- Understand that any Supreme Session costs not covered by my child's fundraising will be the responsibility of the team members family,
- and understand that if I or my child violate the code of conduct, it ****may result in my child being replaced with an alternate for the Supreme Session competition, even if a portion of the Supreme Session costs have been paid for.**

STATE RITUAL TEAM PRACTICES

This year, in order to accommodate daughters from all parts of the state, we will be holding one four-day boot camp-style practice in Olympia Washington. The practice will begin at 10am on Friday, July 26th and will end at 2pm Monday, July 29th.

Daughters will have the opportunity to coordinate lodging or rides with the coaches to make sure they are on time to this practice weekend. More information will be available at Jobie Weekend, but please contact the coaches if you have any questions beforehand.

In addition, we will be holding two fundraisers and a short check-in practice at Grand Session. Daughters are expected to participate in these fundraisers, and need to have their assigned parts memorized at this practice.
