

COOKING COMPETITION – JOBIE WEEKEND

The Cooking Competition is held at Jobie Weekend and is open to all active members of **JOB'S DAUGHTERS INTERNATIONAL and JOBIE TO BEES** who are registered for Jobie Weekend. There will be an opportunity to win a First, Second or Third Place Ribbon in each Class. The Daughter with the Highest overall score in a Division, regardless of the Class competed in, will be awarded a Best In State Ribbon. At the discretion of the judges, a Best In Show maybe awarded for the Highest Score overall in the entire Competition, regardless of Division, Class, or age.

RULES and GUIDELINES

- Must be attending Jobie Weekend to enter Cooking Competition.
- Entries must be received by the entry deadline see online entry form for deadline. No late entries will be accepted. If you would like confirmation your entry was received please email competeJD@gmail.com.
- Each Daughter may enter up to a **total of Three (3) Cooking entries**. You may enter multiple entries per Division or Category, but only one item per type. You can enter multiple Desserts but only one appetizer, for example. Entry forms can be mailed or email together, but each entry must have its own form.
- You must **bring a copy of your recipe with your entry form with** you to give to the judges with your entry. It is not necessary to put your recipe on a recipe card- 8.5x11 paper is fine. **Do not put your name on the recipe copy**. Since the recipe is a judged item, failure to provide a copy of your recipe will result in an automatic 5 point deduction. **So don't forget to bring a copy of all your recipes entered with you!!**
- The entry must have been made entirely by the Daughter whose name is on the entry form. You must be capable of making the entire recipe on your own.
- Please take the time to fill out all the requested information on the entry form. This assists us in making sure your item is entered into the correct Age, Division and Category. Divisions or classes may be revised as determined by the entries received by the deadline.
- **GUIDELINES FOR MYSTERY INGREDIENT ONLY: You need to bring a copy of the recipe** to turn into the judges at Jobie Weekend with your finished dish. An automatic deduction of 5 points is taken for entries that do not have a recipe copy given to the judges when you turn in your entry. **Don't forget your recipe copy!!**
- The **MYSTERY INGREDIENT** will be emailed to you **TWO WEEKS PRIOR** to Jobie Weekend. If you do not hear anything, and you think you should have, please contact the Competition Coordinators @ competeJD@gmail.com.
- The difficulty score is changed to incorporate the Mystery Ingredient. Points will be given based on how well you used the Myster Ingredient in your cooking entry. If there are any additional instructions for this category, they will be included in the email sent when the mystery ingredient is revealed.

Reminders!!!

Division 4 is for Jobie To Bees Only! The Degree of Difficulty score will take into consideration that it is a Jobie To Bee cooking and will be judged accordingly.

THERE ARE NO KITCHEN/COOKING FACILITIES available for use - that includes refrigerators, freezers, microwaves, stoves or ovens. **Please bring your entry COMPLETE and READY to JUDGE.** Please do not ask to store or prep anything at Camp Arnold as the kitchens are completely OFF LIMITS to us at Jobie Weekend.

APPEARANCE Your entry will be judged on presentation - or “eye appeal.” We eat first with our eyes, like when deciding to try something new, and then our mouths. This means that appearance will be focused on what you made and how it looks rather than what it is served in or on.

FOUR PORTIONS FOR THE JUDGES is **ALL** you are allowed to bring to Jobie Weekend. Camp Arnold has agreed to allow us to have the cooking competition **as long as each competitor brings only enough for the judges to taste** their entry. Because of this, we are asking that you **DO NOT BRING** any more than **four** servings for judging.

NO FOOD WILL BE RETURNED TO YOU AFTER JUDGING This means that only non-disposable serving pieces will be returned to you, so be sure and pick those items up soon after your entry has been judged. If you do not wish to have your serving piece returned (example- the disposable plate used) please indicate this at the time you turn your entry in for judging and we will dispose of it for you.

Pinterest Recreation. How it works- Find a Savory or Sweet recipe off Pinterest. Print off the picture (how it's supposed to look) to include with the required recipe. Judges will utilize the picture from Pinterest for the Appearance points.



Cooking Entries will be judged on:

Recipe Sent in With Entry	5 points
Was the Recipe Followed	5 points
Difficulty of Recipe	5 points
Proper Portion	5 points
Taste	55 points
Texture	15 points
Appearance	10 points

A 50 point minimum must be earned out of a possible **100** points to receive a ribbon

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DEADLINE for ENTRY is an ELECTRONIC TIMESTAMP by midnight (see online entry form for deadline date).
