WHAT TO BRING

Smile & a great attitude in addition to your sleeping bag, pillow, and overnight supplies. Remember that men will be on the premises so you should dress appropriately at all times. Please adhere to the Washington Job's Daughters dress code when packing; dressing appropriate is required at all times.

SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS

Everyone will be assigned a cabin. Lights out will be at midnight. Chaperones please see that all your Daughters are accounted for and in their assigned sleeping area by lights out.

FIRST AID

There will not be any nurses on duty, so please bring your own minor emergency kits. If you experience a medical emergency, call 911.

CLEAN UP

Each Bethel is responsible for keeping their area clean. However, we will still need people to help see that everything is in order before we leave. We want to continue to use this BEAUTIFUL FACILITY, please make sure your area is clean before leaving!

CAMP ARNOLD RULES –

- The Salvation Army Camp Arnold maintains a “Tobacco, Alcohol and Illegal Drug Free Environment” and therefore prohibits the use of all tobacco products, alcohol, illegal drugs and misuse of over the counter/prescription drugs.
- Vehicles - Please observe the 10 mile per hour speed limit at all times. A clear fire lane must be maintained to all buildings. Please park in designated areas ONLY. Vehicles that are not designed to carry passengers must not be used to carry passengers on the Camp grounds.
