

INDIVIDUAL RITUAL JUNIOR PRINCESS COMPETITION

Individual Ritual **Junior Princess Competition** is a virtual competition open to all active members of **WASHINGTON JOB'S DAUGHTERS** who hold or have held the Office of Junior Princess in order to compete. The final determination of age divisions will be based upon the number of entries received and competitions completed. You may enter a total of **TWO RITUAL Competitions**.

Virtual Competitions will be held via ZOOM on Saturday June 5, 2021.

You will be contacted to sign up for a competition time slot. Please send separate email to competeJDI@wajdi.org if you have any questions or concerns about the scheduling. At this time we cannot guarantee a specific time slot, but if you have a need for a specific time frame, please let us know and we will do our best to work with you.

RULES and GUIDELINES

- You must be able to log into Zoom at your appointed competition time using a laptop or a desktop with a working camera and mic.
- Each entrant must memorize the **Initiation part**, pages 89-94, including all proficiency work as indicated, including responses to the examination on page 106. If you need a **WORD PROMPT**, three words at a time can be given to you (keep in mind, a point is deducted for each word prompted) you must indicate that you want a prompt as instructed when you check in for your competition.
- **Visual Appearance will be judged.** You may wear a dress or your robe. If you have your robe and wish to wear it, there are two acceptable ways. If you have the Junior Princess's Cape and Crown available to you, you may wear it as per the ritual. If you don't have the cape and crown you may wear your robe with cords attached, tied properly and with a headband worn. You may choose to wear a meeting appropriate dress in place of your robe. You may wear a tiara if you so choose. Keep in mind you need to be fully dressed as if you were going to a meeting in person. Your appearance score will be based upon more than your blouse choice.
- **You will be judged on the exemplification of the Proficiency Lesson, extending your hand towards the emblem of your epoch** as per the ritual and where appropriate.
- **Memorization and Delivery of Speaking Part, Interpretation and Overall Impression will be judged.** Work on eye contact, speaking slowly, clearly and believe the story you are telling. Your delivery should have appropriate expression the story flow smoothly.
