

INDIVIDUAL RITUAL PROFICIENCY COMPETITION

Individual Ritual **PROFICIENCY Competition** is a virtual competition open to all active members of **WASHINGTON JOB'S DAUGHTERS**. You need not to have taken the Proficiency Test at your Bethel prior to competing. Daughters may compete at any age, but may only compete one time in The Proficiency Competition. The final determination of age divisions will be based upon the number of entries received and competitions completed. You may enter a total of **TWO RITUAL Competitions**.

Virtual Competitions will be held via Zoom on Saturday June 5, 2021.

You will be contacted to sign up for a competition time slot. Please send separate email to competeJDI@wajdi.org if you have any questions or concerns about the scheduling. At this time we cannot guarantee a specific time slot, but if you have a need for a specific time frame, please let us know and we will do our best to work with you.

RULES and GUIDELINES

- You must be able to log into Zoom at your appointed competition time using a laptop or a desktop with a working camera and mic.
- Each entrant must memorize the **PROFICIENCY EXAM**. You will need to obtain a copy of the Secret Work from the Guardian Secretary of your Bethel.
- **Visual Appearance will be judged.** You may wear a dress or your robe. If you have your robe and wish to wear it, cords must be attached, tied properly and a headband worn. You may choose to wear a meeting appropriate dress in place of your robe. Keep in mind you need to be fully dressed as if you were going to a meeting in person. Your appearance score will be based upon more than your blouse choice.
- **Attitude of Prayer** as per the ritual will be judged and should be used during the Obligation and the Mother's Father's Prayer.
- **Memorization and Delivery of Speaking Part, Interpretation and Overall Impression will be judged.** Memorization of the **Obligation, Signs, Responses, Mothers' Fathers' and Guardians Prayer, The Salutation Sign and The Grip of The Order**. To assist you, a competition judge will read the sentence immediately before each memory part. (Points are not deducted for these sentences.) If you prefer to omit the prompts, simply let the judges know before you start your competition.

Entries to compete shall be made via ONLINE ENTRY by the ENTRY DEADLINE of Midnight April 30, 2021.
