RULES:

- 1. Open to members of Washington Job's Daughters. Daughters entering only the essay competition need not be present to win.
- 2. Divisions: Class A 16-19 years old

Class B 13-15 years old Class C 10-12 years old

- 3. Essays should be a minimum of 500 words, but not more than 1,000 words. The word count must be completed on the entry form. Remember to count "a", "an", and "the" as words. You must also count numbers such as "1990" and "7" as words.
- 4. Speeches must be at least 2 minutes and no longer than 5 minutes. Points will be deducted for going over the 5 minute time limit.
- 5. This must be your original work as a Daughter. Excerpts from articles or poems, etc. may be used as long as they are enclosed in quotation marks and cited and you write the main content.
- 6. All entries should be typed using double spacing on one side of an 8 1/2 x 11 page.
 - a. Your essay **MUST** be included at the time of entry!
 - b. Your Speech must be presented to the judges at the time of your competition.
- 7. Qualified judges will score the entries based on ideas and content, organization, word choice, sentence fluency, voice and conventions. Judges reserve the right to refuse questionable entries.
