

## INDIVIDUAL RITUAL – HONORED QUEEN COMPETITION

Individual Ritual – **HONORED QUEEN** competition will be held during Grand Session. This competition is for Daughters of all ages who hold or have held the office of Honored Queen at the time of the competition. All eligible Daughters are encouraged to participate. **DIVISION AND AGE CATEGORIES** may be revised as determined by the entries received by the deadline. There will be an opportunity to win a First, Second or Third Place Medal in each Division with a minimum of 1040 points required to place. The Daughter with the Highest overall score in the competition, regardless of the division competed in, will be awarded a Best In State Medal.

### RULES and GUIDELINES

- Must be present to enter Honored Queen Competition.
- Entries must be received by the entry deadline see online entry form for deadline. No late entries will be accepted. If you would like confirmation your entry was received, please email [competejdi@wajdi.org](mailto:competejdi@wajdi.org).
- Competition is open to all active Bethel members who hold or have held the office of Honored Queen at the time of competition. There is no limit to the number of girls per Bethel who may enter.
- **Entrants may only enter one of the four competitions for H.Q, Sr. Princess, Jr. Princess & Guide.**
- Entrants will need to learn the **Initiation part, pages 83-89 through instructions to the Junior Princess, page 94 instructions to the Senior Princess, 100-110, including all proficiency work as indicated and final direction to the Inner Guard.** If you need a **WORD PROMPT**, three words at a time can be given to you (keep in mind, a point is deducted for each word prompted) You must indicate that you want a prompt by making eye contact with the judge.
  - **Appearance & Visual Robe Judging during the competition.**
  - **Memorization and Delivery of Speaking Parts**
  - **Interpretation and Overall Impression**
- Entrants will wear a robe with a white cord, cape and crown, as per ritual and by-laws. Robes will be judged during the competition.
- The judges will be the only ones permitted to have Rituals in the room. To see that the same set of standards are applied to all, each Daughter competing will be judged by the same set of (3 or 4) judges. It is the choice of the Daughter if she would like to have additional observers in the room while she competes. Observers are cautioned not to assist the Daughter in any way during the competition. This includes, talking, prompting, mouthing words, nodding or any other gestures to the Daughter during competition.
- DIVISIONS:
  - Novice A – Age 10 - 13 and 1<sup>st</sup> time competing in Honored Queen Competition
  - Novice B – Age 14 - 19 and 1<sup>st</sup> time competing in Honored Queen Competition
  - Veteran A – Age 10 - 13 Previously competed in Honored Queen Competition
  - Veteran B – Age 14 - 19 Previously competed in Honored Queen Competition
